- Photographs of the nominee

One completed nomination form and report must be submitted for each nomination and sent to the specified location on the back of this brochure **to be received no later than April 1, 2009**. Three finalists for each category will be notified and then announced on the Lions Clubs International Web site (www.lionsclubs.org). Finalists should plan to attend the awards ceremony (at their own expense) held during the 2009 Lions International Convention in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA. International directors will accept awards on behalf of winners from their constitutional areas who are unable to attend.
